Why did Jesus die?

1. Man by nature does evil (wrong).

It is not hard to admit that we all have done things that we know is wrong, but yet we do them anyway. That is called sin! We all are guilty of it we have been doing it since we were born.

John 3:19 Mana creejcuñaka juchachaskaña cancu, imaraycuchus c'anchay cay pachaman jamojtin, paycuna c'anchaymanta nejtin tutayajta munarkancu, mana allincunata ruwaskancuraycu.

Romans 3:23 Tucuy juchallincuncu, salvacoj Diosmantataj carunchacapuncu.



We are all sinners!

2. By that nature we are condemned.

John 6:40 Tataypaj munaynenka caymi: Diospaj Churinta ricuspa paypi creejcuñaka wiñay causayniyoj cancu; nokataj causerichisaj tucucuy p'unchaypi.

John 3:18 “Diospaj Churinpi creejka mana juchachaskachu, mana creejcunataj juchachaskaña cancu, Diospaj ch'ulla Churinpi mana creeskancuraycu.

John 3:36 Diospaj Churinpi creejcunaka wiñaypaj salvaska cankacu; Churipi mana creey munajcunataj mana salvaskachu cankacu, manachayri Dios paycunata sinchita castiganka.



There is a cost for sin!

3. Jesus was in the world and he died for us.

John 14:6 Jesús payta nerkan:

—Noka cani ñan, verdad, causaypas. Nokapi creespalla Tataypajman chayankacu.

John 3:17 Dioska cay pachaman Churinta cachamorkan, mana runacunata juchachananpajchu, manachayri salvananpaj.

John 1:10, 12 Chay Palabra cay pachapi cachcarkan. Payninta Dios cay pachata ruwarkan chaywanpas, cay pachapi caj runacuna mana rejserkancuchu. Chaywanpas picunachus Jesusta jap'ekancu paypitaj creencu, chaycunaman Dios derechota kon paypaj wawancuna canancupaj.

4. Salvation is a free gift, not by good works. You must take God's word for it, and trust Jesus alone!

Salvation is trusting and receiving Jesus Christ as your Savior. It's trusting in the fact that Jesus Christ died on the cross of Calvary to pay for your sins! It's realizing there is absolutely nothing whatsoever you can do to save yourself and *completely* trusting in Jesus Christ to save you! It's not any church that saves. It's not any baptism, not good works, not sacraments, not repenting, not praying through, not living a good life — **IT'S NOT ANYTHING YOU CAN DO!**

Ephesians 2:8-9 Diospaj favorninraycu salvaska canquichis creespalla, mana kancuna quiquiyquichis ruwaskayquichisraycuchu. Salvacionka Diospaj regalon, mana runa quiquinpaj ruwaskanchu, mana pipas ni imamantapas alabacunanpaj.

Tit 3:5 salvawanchis, mana ima allin ruwaskanchisraycuchu, manachayri qhuyapayawaskanchisraycu. Juchanchismanta mayllawaskanchisraycu Dios mosojmanta nacichiwanchis; Santo Espiritu uqhunta cay mosoj causayta kowanchis.

5. You must believe on the Lord and you will have everlasting life!

John 5:24 “Segurayquichis, pipas niskaycunata allinta uyarispa cachamuwajniypi creejka, wiñay causayniyoj, mana juchachaskachu canka. Wañuyanta causayman pasapunña.

John 6:47 Segurayquichis, pipas creejka wiñay causayniyojña.

John 10:28 Noka paycunaman wiñay causayta koni. Chayraycu jayc'ajpas infiernopi sufrenkacuchu, ni pipas nokamanta kechuwankacuchu.

John 20:31 caycuna escribiska cajcunataj kancuna creenayquichispaj Jesús Cristo caskanta, Diospaj Churin caskantapiwan, paypi creespataj salvación causayniyoj canayquichispaj.



If you want to accept Jesus Christ as your Savior and receive forgiveness from God, here is prayer you can pray. Saying this prayer or any other prayer will not save you. It is only trusting in Jesus Christ that can provide forgiveness of sins. This prayer is simply a way to express to God your faith in Him and thank Him for providing for your forgiveness.



"Lord,

I know that I am a sinner. I know that I deserve the consequences of my sin which is death and hell. However, I am trusting in Jesus Christ as my Savior. I believe that His death and resurrection provided for my forgiveness. I trust in Jesus and Jesus alone as my personal Lord and Savior. Thank you Lord, for saving me and forgiving me! Amen!"

If you just prayed that prayer — according to the Word of God — YOU ARE SAVED! HALLELUJAH!

You say, but I don't feel any different. Guess what? Your salvation does not depend on your feeling. **It ALL depends on doing what God SAID!**

God said if you receive and trust in Jesus Christ you are saved. Notice it does NOT say you "might" or "could" be saved — but "shall be saved". **YOU ARE SAVED!**

Escrituraka nin: "Señorpaj sutinpi salvacionta tucuy mañacojcnaka salvaska cancacu." Romans 10:13

Didn't you just believe on the Lord Jesus Christ? Look at what John 3:36 says! It says you **HATH EVERLASTING LIFE!** Not "maybe" or "hope so" — **BUT HATH — YOU ARE SAVED!**
