Why did Jesus die?

1. Man by nature does evil (wrong).

San Juan 3:19 Díamacă cūre ca tuo nūnūjeetiră pea mee ūañaro tiircarăpă nii yerijāama. ūañarije wado ca tii niirucură niiri, Jesucristo añurije wado ca tiigă ati yepapăre că ca doori tabere, Jesucristo peere boorica tabe unora ca naitūrije peere boo ametūnenecăupa.

2. By that nature we are condemned.

San Juan 3:18 Umureco Pacă Macăre díamacă ca tuo nūnūjeegăa, ūañaro tii yaio ecotirucumi. Díamacă cūre ca tuo nūnūjeetigă doca, mee ūañaro ca tii ecoricăpă nii yerijāami, Umureco Pacă Macă jīcăra ca niigăre díamacă că ca tuo nūnūjeetirije wapa.

San Juan 3:36 To biri cū Macūre díamacū ca tūo nūnūjeegūa, to birora caticōa niiriquere cūomi. Umureco Pacū Macūre díamacū ca tūo nūnūjeerūgatigū pea, tee caticōa niiriquere cūotirucumi. Umureco Pacū ñañaro cū ca tiiriye peere ñañaro peti tamhorucumi —īupi.

3. Jesus was in the world and he died for us.

San Juan 14:6 To biro cūre cū ca īiro, Jesús pea o biro cūre ī yūwūwi: —Yū yū nii, tii maa, díamacū wado ca īigū, caticōa niiriquere ca tiicojogū, yū jūori wado yū Pacū pūtopūre ea waa majirique nii.

San Juan 6:40 Yū Pacū cū ca boorijea, yū, cū Macūre ca īa majirā niipetirā yū ca wederijere díamacū tūo nūnūjeeri, caticōa niirique cūja ca būape nii. Yū pea ca tūjari rūmū ca niiro, cūja ca cati tuaro yū tiirucu —cūjare īwi Jesús.

San Juan 3:17 Umureco Pacua, bojocare ñañaro tiirūgū méé, cū Macūre tiicojoupi. Cū jūori bojocare ametūenerūgū pee cūre tiicojoupi.

San Juan 1:10,12 Cristo, wederique ca niicūra, ati yepapūre niiwi. Cristo menara Umureco Pacū ati yepare cū ca jeeñorique to ca niicā pacaro, ati yepa macārā pea cūre īa majitiwa. To biro cūja ca bii pacaro, añuro cūre ñee, cūre tūo nūnūjee, ca tiirā peera, Umureco Pacū puna peti cūja ca niiro cūjare tiiwi.

4. Salvation is a free gift, not by good works. You must take God's word for it, and trust Jesus alone!

Hechos 4:12 To biri apī jīcū uno peera ñañaro mani ca biipere manire ca ametūenegū manimi. “Ñañaro cūja ca bii yaiboriquere cū jūori ametūarucuma,” īigū Umureco Pacū cū ca tiicojoricū, ati yepa niipetiropūrena apī manicāmi —cūjare ī yūupi Pedro.

Efesios 2:8-9 Umureco Pacū ca bojoca añugū cū ca niiro macā, díamacū tūo nūcū būorique jūorira mūja ametūene ecoupa. Atea mūja majurope mūja ca būarique méé nii. Umureco Pacū wapa manirora cū ca tiicojorije nii. Añurije tii niirique jūori méé bii. Jīcū uno peera, “O biro jāa ca tiiriye jūori, teere jāa būawū,” cūja ca ī nucū yujutipere biro īro.



San Juan 5:24 "Díamac̄ m̄jare ȳ ū ū: Ȳ ca wederijere t̄o, ȳre ca tiicojo cojoric̄re t̄o n̄n̄jee, ca tiigua, to birora caticōa niiriquere c̄om̄i. Ñañaro tii yaio ecotirucumi, mee c̄ ca bii yaiboriquere amet̄uari caticōa niirique peere ca b̄uaric̄ niiri.

San Juan 6:47 Yee méé m̄jare ȳ ū ū: Díamac̄ ȳre ca t̄o n̄n̄jeerā, to birora caticōa niiriquere c̄o yerijāama.

San Juan 10:28 To biri ȳa, to birora caticōa niiriquere c̄jare ȳ tiicojo, j̄ic̄ti t̄no peera bii yaicoa, j̄ic̄t̄no peera c̄jare ȳre ēma, tiitirucumi.
