Why did Jesus die?

1. Man by nature does evil (wrong).

2. By that nature we are condemned.

3. Jesus was in the world and he died for us.

San Juan 1:10,12 Cristo, wederique ca niirc̄ra, ati yepar̄re niwi. Cristo menara ̄m̄reco Pac̄ ati yepare c̄ ca jeeñorique to ca niic̄a pacaro, ati yepa mac̄r̄ pea c̄re ĩa majitiwa. To biro c̄ja ca bii pacaro, añuro c̄re ñee, c̄re t̄o n̄n̄jee, ca tiir̄ peera, ̄m̄reco Pac̄ puna peti c̄ja ca niiro c̄jare tiwi.

4. Salvation is a free gift, not by good works. You must take God's word for it, and trust Jesus alone!

Efesios 2:8-9 ̄m̄reco Pac̄ ca bojoca añuḡ c̄ ca niiro mac̄, díamac̄ t̄o n̄c̄ b̄oriquere j̄orira m̄ja amet̄ene ecoupa. Atea m̄ja majurope m̄ja ca b̄arique méé nii. ̄m̄reco Pac̄ wapa manirora c̄ ca tiicojorije nii. Añurije tii niirique j̄ori méé bii. ĩc̄ ̄no peera, “O biro j̄a ca tiirije j̄ori, teere j̄a b̄aw̄,” c̄ja ca ĩ nuc̄ yujutipere biro ĩro.

Tito 3:5 c̄ra manire amet̄enewi. Mani majuropeera añurije mani ca tiirije j̄ori méé, manire c̄ ca ĩa mairije j̄ori pee manire amet̄enewi. Mani ca ñañarijere c̄ ca coerije mena, w̄ma ca bāar̄e biro manire c̄ ca tiirije mena, to biic̄ari Añuri Yeri j̄ori w̄ma catirique manire c̄ ca tiicojorije mena, manire amet̄eneupi.

5. You must believe on the Lord and you will have everlasting life!

San Juan 5:24 "Díamac̄ m̄jare ȳ ĩ: Ȳ ca wederijere t̄o, ȳre ca tiicojo cojoric̄re t̄o n̄n̄jee, ca tiiḡa, to birora catic̄o niiriquere c̄omi. Ñañaro tii yaio ecotirucumi, mee c̄ ca bii yaiboriquere amet̄ari catic̄o niirique peere ca b̄aric̄ niiri.

San Juan 6:47 Yee méé m̄jare ȳ ĩ: Díamac̄ ȳre ca t̄o n̄n̄jeer̄a, to birora catic̄o niiriquere c̄o yerij̄ama.

San Juan 10:28 To biri ȳa, to birora catic̄o niiriquere c̄jare ȳ tiicojo, ĩc̄ati ñno peera bii yaicoa, ĩc̄ ñno peera c̄jare ȳre ěma, tiitirucumi.
