1. Because we are all sinners!

Marcos 2:17 Jesupé teeré tuogú, cūñärë jīiyigu: —Diaremanirä ueotigüre boorícua; diarecütira dícu-ueotigüre boocúa. “Ãñuré dícu-tiia” jīrarrë ãmaãgë-atiriwu; ñañaré tiirápere ãmaãgë-atiwu, jīiyigu.

Romanos 3:10 Tee maquérë Cõamacüye queti jóaripüpu-jóanoä: Sícüno ãñuré tiigú-manii.

Tito 3:5 Teero tiigú, marīrē netōnérigu-niiwī. Marī āñurō tiirére īñagū-mee netōnérigu-niiwī. Cūū-bóaneō īñaré cuojígū, marīrē netōnérigu-niiwī. Cūū-coserémena wīmarā sicato bauára tiiróbiro tiirígu-niiwī. Espíritu Santomena marī atibúrecopure “mama wācūrére cuorá niiādacu” jīirigu-niiwī.


5. We must put our faith and trust in Christ alone!

Marcos 1:15 “Cōāmacū-dutiré mūäpure niiādare jeaadropu-tiia. Teero tiirá, múa ñañaré tiirére wācūpati, wasoyá. Teero biiri Cōāmacū-basocáre netōnérre quetire padeoyá”, jīiyigu-

Marcos 10:15 Yuh-ateréja diamacúrā jīrā: Aniágā tiiróbiro Cōāmacū-dutirére ãñurō wācūnunuse tiihéranorē cūdutiré cūapure jeaboarigue cūärē jearicu, jīyigu-

Romanos 10:9-10,13 “Jesucristo yuh-Ópū-nií” jī wedegúno “Cōāmacū-Jesucristo diarigupure masoyigu” jī padeó wācūnunusegu, netónénogüdaqui. Jesucristore padeó wācūnunuseguenorē Cōāmacū-“ãñugúrā nií” jīqui. Cūrā “Jesucristo yuh-Ópū-nií” jī wederi, Cōāmacū-netónégüdaqui. Cōāmacūye queti jóaripupu-biilo jóanoā súcā: “ ‘Ópū, yuhre netónéña’ jī sāigúno netónénogüdaqui”, jī jóanoā.
